The Gilman Study Abroad Scholarship offers low income students absolutely the best opportunity you will ever have to spend a semester in another country. And---they also badly want community college, ethnically diverse, and disabled students to apply.

Here's how it works: you identify a college or university whose credits your home institution will accept. You will be able to use the financial aid you already have; this scholarship **is available only to Pell Grant recipients**. The Gilman Scholarship will give you up to \$5000 for your semester abroad, and if you apply to a country whose language is identified as one of "critical need," you can also receive up to \$3000 for language study.

If you have ever wanted to study in another country, now's your chance! ***The application deadline for spring 2010 is October 6, 2009.*** Please consider this opportunity; it could change your life!
